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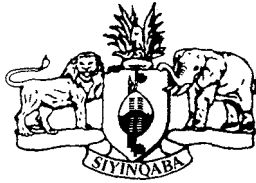
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## PART B

THE APPROPRIATION ACT, 2011  
(Act No. 5 of 2011)

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I ASSENT

**MSWATI III**  
King of Swaziland

31<sup>st</sup> March, 2011

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**AN ACT**  
**ENTITLED**

**AN ACT** to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2011 and ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012.

**ENACTED** by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

***Short Title and Commencement***

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2011 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2011.

***Charge to Consolidated Fund***

2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate Ten Billion, Six Hundred and Twenty Nine Million, and Thirty One Thousand Emalangeni (E10,629,031,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2011 and ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2012.

***Application of sum appropriated***

3. The sum appropriated by Section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the second column of the Schedule and in the respective amounts appearing in the third and fourth columns in respect of each service.
