THE STATUTES OF SWAZILAND ACT, 1970
(Act No. 14 of 1970)THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE EDITORIAL BOARD FOR STATUTES
REVISION AND COMPILATION OF THE SWAZILAND
LAW REPORTS NOTICE, 2012
(Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Statutes of Swaziland Act, 1970 read together with section 10 of the Interpretation Act, 1970, the Attorney General issues the following Notice -

Citation and Commencement

1. (1) This Notice may be cited as the Establishment of the Editorial Board for Statutes Revision and Compilation of the Swaziland Law Reports Notice, 2012.

(2) This Notice shall come into force on the date of publication in the gazette.

Establishment of the Board

2. (1) There is established a Board to be known as the Editorial Board for Statute Revision and Compilation of Swaziland Law Reports.

(2) The Board shall consist of -

Duties of the Board

3. (1) The Board shall revise, update and cause to be published by Lexis Nexis (Butterworth) Publishing Company the Swaziland Law Reports from 2010 and in performing this task, it shall

Prohibition of action or proceedings in absence of bad faith or malice

64. There shall be no action or proceedings against the Council, a Disciplinary Committee, an investigation committee or any member of the Council, a Disciplinary Committee or investigation committee for any act or thing done under this Act unless it is proved to the court that the Act or thing was done in bad faith or with malice.

Regulations

65. (1) The Minister may, in consultation with the Council, make regulations for carrying out the purposes of this Act and for any matter which is required under this Act to be prescribed.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1), the Minister may make regulations-

- (a) prescribing the forms of applications under this Act and certificates of registration, practicing certificates and licences;
- (b) prescribing the fees payable to the Council under this Act;
- (c) prescribing the form of the registers to be kept by Council;
- (d) prescribing a code of professional conduct and ethics;
- (e) requiring any registered architect, engineer, quantity surveyor or allied professional to take out and maintain insurance against liability for breach of professional duty in the course of supplying architectural, engineering, quantity surveying services or allied professional work;
- (f) prescribing the terms and conditions of insurance against professional liability under this Act, including a minimum limit of indemnity;
- (g) prescribing the remuneration and allowances of Council and committee members;
and
- (h) prescribing anything which is permitted or required by this Act to be prescribed.

- (a) compile the judgments;
- (b) read and make case summaries, fly -notes, head notes and indexes;
- (c) check and make corrections to dumb volumes including pagination and final checks;
and
- (d) proof read the galley - proof pages.

(2) The Board shall, in order to meet the deadlines set in the contract between the Judiciary and Lexis Nexis (Butterworth) Publishing Company, work beyond Government working hours and on weekends.

Duration of the Board

- 4. The Board shall commence its duties from the 2nd January, 2013 to 2nd January, 2015.

Payment of the Board

- 5. The Board shall be paid such allowances as are payable to Members of Committees under the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963.
