LEGAL NOTICE NO. 79 OF 1979

THE CENTRAL BANK OF SWAZILAND ORDER, 1974

(Order No. 6 of 1974)

HIS MAJESTY'S 80TH BIRTHDAY ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIVE COIN
ISSUE NOTICE, 1979*[Date of commencement: 5th September, 1979]*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 4, 22, 23 and 26 of the Central Bank of Swaziland Order, 1974 (Order No. 6 of 1974) I, ANTHONY DENIS OCKENDEN! Acting Governor of the Central Bank of Swaziland, do hereby issue the following Notice:—

Citation.

1. This Notice may be cited as His Majesty's 80th Birthday Anniversary Commemorative Coin Issue Notice, 1979.

Interpretation.

2. In this Notice unless the context otherwise requires —

“Commemorative Coins” or “Commemorative Issue” means His Majesty's 80th Birthday Anniversary Commemorative Gold Coins issued in terms of this Notice.

Commemorative Issue.

3. The coins to be issued by the Central Bank of Swaziland shall be a special commemorative issue honouring His Majesty's 80th Birthday and shall be known as “His Majesty's 80th Birthday Anniversary Commemorative Coins”.

Denominations, Dimensions, Weights and Quantities.

4. The Commemorative Issue shall consist of gold coins of the following denominations, measurements, weights and quantities:

<i>Denomination of Coin</i>	<i>Diameter in Millimetres</i>	<i>Weight in Grams</i>	<i>Number of Coins to be minted</i>
L1	27.69	15.55	Unlimited
E2	31.65	31.10	Unlimited

Shape of Commemorative Coins.

5. Both the lilangeni (L1) and the 2 Emalangeni (E2) Gold Coins shall be round and with serrated edges.

Fineness.

6. All Gold Coins in the Commemorative Issue shall be of fineness of nine hundred and ninety-nine plus (999+) fine.

Design and Inscription.

7. The Commemorative Coins shall bear the following designs and inscriptions:

- (1) On the obverse side of the 1 Lilangeni (L1) gold coin —
 - (a) in the centre, the image of His Majesty, King Sobhuza II with the date 1899 on the left and the date 1979 on the right;
 - (b) along the upper edge, following the curve of the coin the words in one line in the English language "Kingdom of Swaziland";
 - (c) below the image of His Majesty the words "SOBHUZA II".
- (2) On the reverse side of the 1 Lilangeni (L1) gold coin —
 - (a) in the centre the image of the Swaziland Coat of Arms;
 - (b) above the said Coat of Arms the dates 1922-1979;
 - (c) below the said Coat of Arms the mint mark inscription $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. 24K Fine Gold;
 - (d) along the lower edge following the curve of the coin the words "1 Lilangeni".
- (3) On the obverse side of the 2 Emalangeni (E2) gold coin —
 - (a) in the centre, the image of His Majesty King Sobhuza II with the date 1899 on the left and the date 1979 on the right;
 - (b) along the upper edge above the image of His Majesty and following the curve of the coin the words in one line in the English language "KINGDOM OF SWAZILAND";
 - (c) below the image of His Majesty the words "SOBHUZA II".
- (4) On the reverse side of the 2 Emalangeni (E2) gold coin —
 - (a) in the centre the image of the Swaziland Coat of Arms;
 - (b) above the said Coat of Arms the dates 1922-1979;
 - (c) below the said Coat of Arms the mint mark inscription 1 oz. 24K Fine Gold;
 - (d) following the curve of the coin along the lower edge the words "2 Emalangeneni".
