REGENT'S DECREE NO. 1 OF 1985

THE KING'S PROCLAMATION (AMENDMENT) DECREE, 1985

In exercise of the powers vested in me and in accordance with paragraph 14 of the King's Proclamation to the Nation of the 12th April, 1973, I NTOMBI, Ndlovukazi and Regent of the Kingdom of Swaziland, hereby make the following Decree —

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the King's Proclamation (Amendment) Decree, 1985 and shall be read as one with the King's Proclamation to the Nation of the 12th April, 1973.

Amendment of paragraph 3 of Decree.

- 2. Paragraph 3 of the Decree contained in the King's Proclamation is amended—
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (c) by replacing subsection (2) of section 30 of the repealed Constitution with the following—
 - "(2) If the Regent is for any reason unable to perform the functions of her office, a person shall be appointed in accordance with Swazi law and custom to perform her functions during such inability."
 - (b) in section 34 of the repealed Constitution by replacing the words "An authorised person" with the words "A person appointed under section 30(2)"; and
 - (c) by adding the following section after section 34 —

"Other immunities.

34 bis The person appointed under section 30(2) shall have the same immunities as are conferred by section 35 in respect of all things done or omitted to be done by him only in his official capacity and while performing such functions."

Amendment of paragraph 10 of Decree.

3. Paragraph 10 of the Decree is amended by replacing the definition "Liqoqo" with the following —

to a office a second

"Liqoqo" means a Council whose function is to advise the King and which shall consist of members appointed by the King to hold office at his pleasure in accordance with such terms and conditions (including emoluments and allowances) as he may determine".
