Functions of the committee.

- 2. The Committee shall -
 - (a) review the Industrial Relations Act, No. 1 of 1996;
 - (b) consider any submissions made before the labour Advisory Board by persons representing labour, business and Government;
 - (c) prepare a draft Bill of a proposed Industrial Relations legislation;
 - (d) deliver a final draft of the Bill to the Labour Advisory Board at the time specified under section 3 of this Notice.

Draft Bill to be presented to the Labour Advisory Board.

3. The Committee shall deliver a draft Bill of the proposed Industrial Relations legislation not later than 9th March 1998.

Allowances.

4. The Committee shall be paid sitting and travelling allowances equal to those payable to persons in statutory bodies.

Extension of time.

5. The Labour Advisory Board in consultation with the Minister may extend the time specified under section 3 of the Notice by notice published in the Gazette.
