LEGAL NOTICE NO. 107 OF 1998

THE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND AUDIT ACT, 1967 (Act No. 18 of 1967)

THE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND ACCOUNTING (PUBLIC HEALTH) REGULATIONS 1998 (Under Section 26)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Financial Management and Audit Act, 1967 the Minister for Finance in consultation with the Minister for health issues the following Instructions or Regulations.

Citation and Commencement.

 These Instructions or Regulations may be cited as the Financial Management and Accounting (Public Health) Regulations, 1998 and shall come into force on 1st August 1998.

NOTES:

- All patients are expected to pay the service charge. Anyone unable to pay may have the fees waived provided there is documented evidence from Director of Health Services and Regional Administrators.
- 2. Non-resident general outpatients shall be charged three times the general rates.
- 3. Prison patients and police requests are free.
- Reattendances is declined as a follow up visit within seven days or within a longer period unless authorised in writing by the clinician.
- 5. All attendance for TB Leprosy and Mental Services shall be free.
- 6. Patients on Medical Aids shall be charged medical aid rates.
- 7. Cash patients may be graded according to their earnings.
