Citation and commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the Swaziland National Population Council (Amendment) Notice, 2001 and shall be read as one with Legal Notice No. 156 of 1998 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on 1st November. 2000.

Amendment of section 2.

THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NATIONAL POPULATION POLICY DRAFTING COMMITTEE NOTICE, 2001 (Under section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commission of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister of Economic Planning and Development issues the following notice -

Citation and Commencement.

 This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the National Population Policy Drafting Committee Notice, 2001 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st November, 2000.

Establishment and Composition of the Drafting Committee.

2. (1) There is hereby established a committee to be known as the National Population Policy Drafting Committee (hereafter referred to as "the Drafting Committee" and shall be composed of the following persons as members -

Principal functions of the Drafting Committee

- 3. (1). The principal functions of the Drafting Committee will include the following:
 - (a) Participation in all activities necessary for the drafting of the policy;
 - (b) Allocation of responsibilities among its members in undertaking all activities necessary for the drafting of the policy, including the preparation of initial and final drafts of the policy document;
 - (c) Establish, as necessary, subcommittees to undertake specific tasks that will assist the Drafting Committee to fulfil its mandate
 - (d) Identification of issues that should be addressed in the policy, and determination of how they will actually be addressed;
 - (e) Prepare preliminary drafts of the policy document, based on the contents of the sectoral/thematic submissions and any other pertinent information, following the structure of the document as agreed upon by the Drafting Committee;
 - (f) Revise preliminary drafts of the policy document based on comments received from the NPC and all other sources including discussions at district and central levels, and by key stakeholders;

- (g) Undertake final revision of draft policy based on comments received from the NPC and during consultations with civil society and any other consensus-building activities;
- (h) Submit to the Population Secretariat final draft of policy document for distribution to National Population Council, NPC for its final endorsement before it is subsequently submitted to government for approval;
- (2) The Drafting Committee shall not later than 31st December 2000 deliver an interim report to the Population Secretariat for onward delivery to the NPC, failure of which the NPC may take appropriate action to ensure compliance.
- (3) The Drafting Committee shall deliver a final report to the Population Secretariat for onward delivery to the NPC not later than the 30th day of June, 2001, or such later date as the Minister may allow.
- (4) The Drafting committee will be answerable to the National Population Council (NPC) through the Population Secretariat;

Allowance and reimbursements

4. The members of the Drafting Committee shall be entitled to sitting allowances and where applicable, reimbursements for travelling expense. The Drafting Committee shall be paid a total of 80 man-days split into two equal payments, the first payment equivalent to 40 man-days after presentation of the interim report and final payment also equivalent to 40 man-days after delivery of the final report.

Extension of time

- 5. The Minister may extend the time for the submission of the final report.
- (1) The Minister shall seek approval from cabinet for any extension of time for the submission of the final report on the advice of the NPC.
