### LEGAL NOTICE NO. 40 OF 2004

### THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1983 (Act NO. 7 of 1983)

## THE NOTICE OF INTENTION OF REVIEW THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM EARNINGS) NOTICE, 2004 [Under Sections 10 (1) and 45 (1)]

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45 (1) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment hereby issues the following Notice:-

#### Citation and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Notice of Intention to Review the Workmen's Compensation (Minimum and Maximum Earnings) Notice, 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>rt</sup> April, 2004.

### Review of minimum and maximum earning.

- (a) In consideration of the general level of prices and earnings, the Minister of Enterprise and Employment intends to make regulations reviewing the minimum and maximum earnings as stipulated in section 45 (1) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983.
  - (b) The minimum and maximum earnings for the purpose of calculation of compensation in terms of section 10 (1) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983 (which are calculated at 15% per annum) are reviewed as shown in the Schedule to this Notice.
  - (c) The amounts listed in the Schedule for the years 1999 to 2004 are for the purposes of illustrating the method of arriving at the new rates for the minimum and maximum earnings.
  - (d) No Workmen's Compensation claims shall be paid in arrears as a result of the review of the minimum earnings.

### Revocation of Legal Notice No. 109 of 1999

3. The Maximum and Minimum Earnings (Rate of Compensation) Regulations, 1999 is hereby revoked.

### THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1983 (Act NO. 7 of 1983)

# THE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REVIEW THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (MEDICAL EXPENSES) NOTICE, 2004 [Under Sections 30 (2) and 45 (2)]

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 45 (2) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, after consultation with the Minister for Health and Social Welfare, hereby issues the following Notice -

#### Citation and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Notice of Intention to Review the Workmen's Compensation (Medical Expenses) Notice, 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st April, 2004.

### Medical expenses payable by employer.

- (a) In consideration of the general level of prices (the inflation rate) the Minister for Enterprise
  and Employment intends to make regulations reviewing the medical expenses as stipulated in
  section 45 (2) of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983.
  - (b) The limit of medical expenses to be paid by an employer on behalf of a workman is increased by 15% as shown in the Schedule to this Notice.
  - (c) The amounts listed in the Schedule for the years 1999 to 2004 are for the purposes of illustrating the method of arriving at the new rates of medical expenses.

(d) No medical expenses claim shall be paid in arrears as a result of this review of maximum medical expenses.

### Revocation of Legal Notice No. 49 of 1999

3. The Workmen's Compensation (Medical Expenses) Regulations, 1999 is hereby revoked.
