THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (Act No. 36 of 1963)

APPOINTMENT OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE JOZINI BIG SIX INVESTMENT INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT NOTICE, 2005 (Under section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment issues the following Notice -

Citation and Commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the Technical Committee for the Implementation of the Jozini Big Six Investment Infrastructure Development Notice, 2005, and shall come into force on the 1st November 2005.

Establishment and Composition of the Committee

2. There is establishment a committee to be known as the Technical Committee for the Implementation of the Jozini Big Six Investment Infrastructure Development Committee (hereinafter referred to as " the committee"), which shall be composed of the following persons -

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Functions of the Committee

- 3. The Committee shall perform the following functions;
 - (a) guide and assist the implementation process of the Jozini Big Six Project.
 - (b) facilitate processing of utilities infrastructure installation in the project area.
 - (c) liaise with the Government of Swaziland on all issues that require Government's consent and approval for the implementation of the project.
 - (d) assist Government and project promoters on securing an alternative location for the livestock currently occupying the project area.
 - (e) ensure that the principles of the Lubombo Spatial Development Initiative are upheld in the development and implementation of the project.
 - (f) assist in the processing of water rights and access to the mass water of Jozini Dam for the development and management of a Holiday Resort on the project area.
 - (g) facilitate negotiations between the Government of Swaziland and that of the Republic of South Africa, in relation to:
 - (i) Access to and use of the Jozini Dam water mass for water sports and tiger fishing.
 - (ii) Transfrontier movement of game between South Africa and Swaziland.
 - (iii) Ensuring easy access and use of the facilities of the Holiday Resort from South Africa.
 - (h) Ensure that the implementation of the project takes cognisance of and protects the rights of the Ingwenyama, Lavumisa Community and, the Swazi Nation.

(i) Ensure that the use of the Jozini Dam water mass and the carrying out of activities around it, promote and sustain the relations between Swaziland and South Africa, particularly in relation to the movement of people within the Jozini Dam area, and the treatment of effluent and emissions.

Term of office

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4. A member of the committee shall hold office for the duration of the implementation process of the project and shall cease to hold office upon completion of the project.

Provided that the Minister for Enterprise and Employment shall have the power to remove a member from the committee, who, due to certain circumstances can no longer be part of the committee or cannot reasonable be expected to participate in the activities of the committee.

Allowances

5. Members of the committee shall be entitled to such allowances, and where applicable reimbursement for travelling expenses in the same manner and rates as those applicable to Commissions of Enquiry, and in terms of Finance Circular No. 2 of 2005.

Frequency of meetings

6. The committe shall hold at least three (3) meetings per month for the first six (6) months of its appointment and thereafter at least two (2) meetings per month.

Quorum

7. The chairperson or, in his absence, the deputy chairperson, and eleven members shall constitute a quorum.
