LEGAL NOTICE NO. 65 OF 2008

THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (ACT No. 35 of 1963)

THE COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY INTO THE OPERATIONS OF THE CENTRAL TRANSPORT ADMINISTRATION (AMENDMENT), NOTICE 2008 (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, of 1963, the Prime Minister issues the following Notice -

Citation

1. This Notice may be cited as the Commission of Enquiry Into the Operations of the Central Transport Administration (Amendment) Notice, 2008 and shall be read as one with legal Notice 22 of 2007 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Notice).

Amendment of Section 2

2. Section 2 (2) of the Principal Notice is amended by adding -

Tersia Rossouw

Member

Jaco de Bruin

alternate Secretary

as members of the Commission.

Amendment of Section 3

- 3. (a) Section 3 (2) of the Principal Notice is amended in -
 - (i) paragraph (e) by -

deleting paragraph (e) and renumbering accordingly;

(ii) paragraph (g) by -

removing ";" after the word "vehicles" and adding the words "for purposes of serving them;";

(iii) paragraph (j) by -

adding the words "including fuel," in between the words "stock" and "verification"

(iv) paragraph (m) by

deleting paragraph (m) and replacing it with a new paragraph (m) as follows; "(m) undertake an audit of the -

- (i) composition (including skills profiles), utilisation and cost of CT A staff;
- (ii) strengths and weaknesses of internal control(s).

(b) subsection 3 is amended -

by deleting subsection (3) and replacing it with a new subsection (3) as follows -

- "(3)(a) the commission shall prepare a comprehensive report and make recommendations as to whether there are persons involved in any wrongdoing or breach of any law or regulations who should be charged with an offence, disciplined or surcharged;
- (b) any issue identified which is not directly related to the above shall be included in the report under a separate heading; and
- (c) the enquiry shall be held in camera."

Amendment of Section 5

4. Section 5 (1) is amended by removing the words "at the end of March, 2008 and replacing them with the words "at the end of June, 2008."
